INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE
(For the Students Studying Class VIII)

1. Make sure that the Admit Card is not detached from the Application Form. Admit cards will be sent to the Chief Superintendent of the examination center after allotting the Roll Numbers. Candidate can collect the admit card from the Chief Superintendent of the examination center **at least one week** before the examination.
2. Reach the Examination Centre at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination; and occupy the seat that bears your Roll Number.
3. **DO NOT** take calculator, mathematical & physical table or any other kind of ready reckoner to the examination hall.
4. The examination will be conducted in two sessions on the same day.
5. You have to take the examination in **TWO PARTS**: (i) Part I: Mental Ability Test (MAT) (ii) Part II: Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT). The SAT will consist items from Science, Social Studies and from Mathematics. The applicants are requested to refer/consult State Liaison Officer for the composition of test.
6. Time for Part I and Part II is 90 minutes respectively.
7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the Answer Sheet and on the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
9. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question **FOUR** possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer sheet.
10. Record your answer-using Ball Point Pen only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised by the State/UT.
11. During the Examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
12. Hand over your Answer sheet to the Invigilator before you leave the Examination Hall.
13. **Hand over the admission card to the Invigilator before leaving the Examination Hall.**
